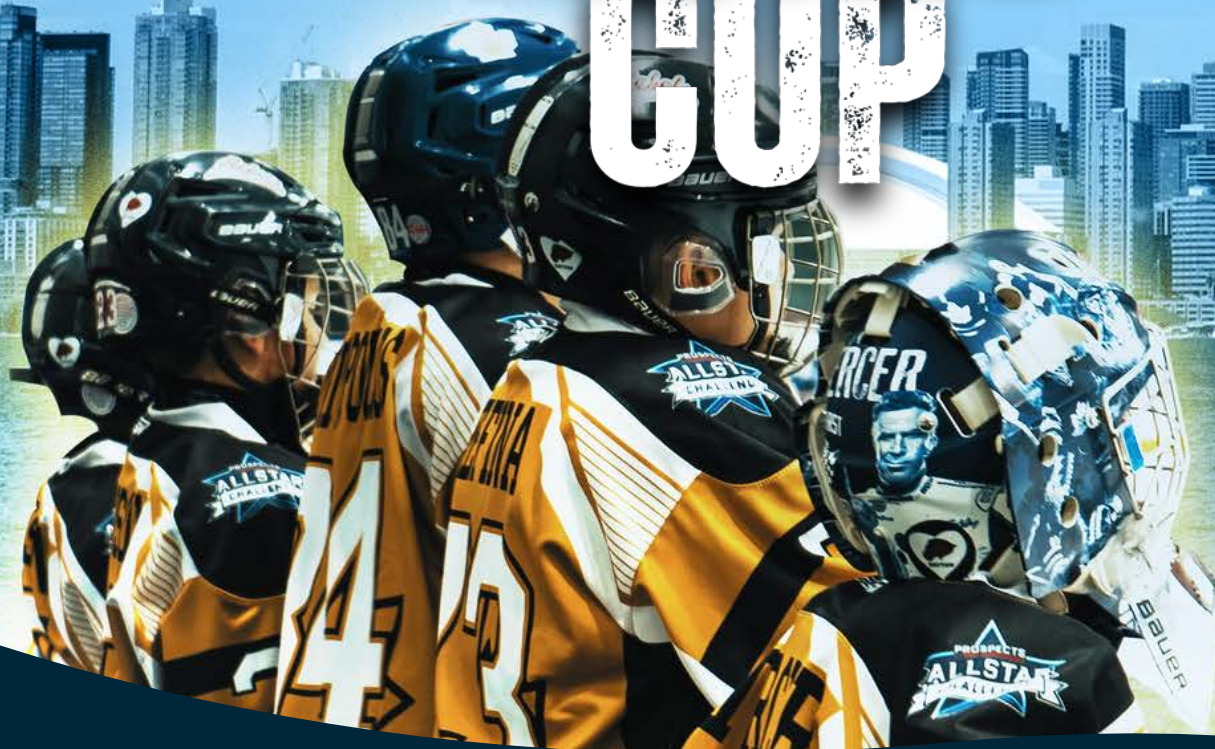

Home of the Toronto Maple Leafs, OHL, GTHL, and many more, this city is the hub of hockey.

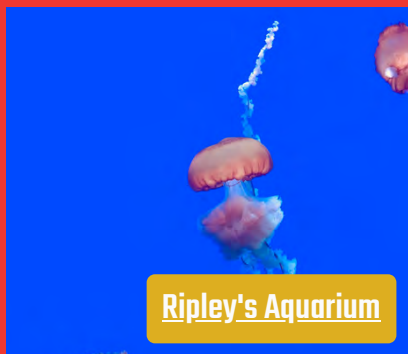

Ripley's Aquarium



Underwater wonders are yours with PSI! Be swept away at Ripley's Aquarium of Canada! Located in downtown Toronto, just southeast of the CN Tower, this aquarium is one of three aquariums owned-and-operated by Ripley Entertainment.

The aquarium has 5.7 million litres of marine and freshwater habitats from across the world. The exhibits hold more than 20,000 exotic sea and freshwater specimens from more than 450 species.

Immerse yourself in Dangerous Lagoon, a breathtaking underwater gallery, and come face to face with some of the Aquarium's most jaw-dropping species. Hop onto the moving sidewalk and get up close and personal with a wide array of sharks while keeping your eyes peeled for the two resident green sea turtles, Queensland grouper, and other species of fish and invertebrates who call this exhibit home. Or take in Ray Bay featuring four species of stingray and one species of shark!

Toronto Football Club

PSI delivers the wonder of major sporting events! Take in a match and watch Toronto Football Club, a Canadian professional soccer club based in Toronto that competes in Major League Soccer. Owned by Maple Leaf Sports and Entertainment, which also owns the Toronto Maple Leafs hockey team, the Toronto FC plays its home matches at BMO Field, located at Exhibition Place on Toronto's shoreline west of Downtown Toronto.



In 2017, Toronto FC won the domestic treble with the MLS Cup, Supporters' Shield and Canadian Championship, making them the first and only MLS club to ever do so. They are eight-time winners of the Canadian Championship and were runners-up of the 2018 CONCACAF Champions League and the MLS Cup in 2016 and 2019.
